Frequently Asked Questions

What types of organisations and institutions are supported through the ESP?

Funding through the ESP is available to representatives of government, civil society, research and academia, the technical community and private sector with a strong interest in and motivation to contribute to the global discussions on the use of ICTs for international peace and security.

Are there any topics of particular interest?

Yes. Funding is meant in particular for organisations interested in the issues within the OEWG's mandate: existing and emerging threats, norms of responsible behaviour, the application of international law in cyberspace, confidence-building measures and capacity building in cyberspace.

We welcome in particular applications from organisations and entities that:

- > implement concrete projects and activities in those areas
- > can provide insights from national, regional, or community-specific fora
- > offer a new and unique perspective on those topics.

Will I receive the funding directly?

No. The travel arrangement and accommodation will be arranged through EU Cyber Direct – an EU-funded project aimed to support the EU's cyber diplomacy. Selected grantees will be responsible for making their own visa arrangements. Participants will also receive a per diem payable after the conference. In exceptional cases, however, we might proceed with a partial advance payment.
